

TIMANOUS UNIFORM & EQUIPMENT

All Timanous campers wear uniforms. The catalog from our uniform supplier, Maine Camp Outfitters, contains all the required and optional clothing for a summer at Timanous and is linked on the Summer FAQ page of our website. Please use our list titled "Camp Timanous Uniform and Equipment List" as your guide for required clothing and please attach a completed form to the inside of the trunk or bring it with you on opening day. Shipping

If shipping luggage, UPS or FedEx can send baggage at least two weeks before the start of camp directly to Camp Timanous, 85 Plains Road, Raymond, ME 04071. A sturdy trunk has been found to be the most suitable container as it can be placed beside a camper's bed and used for storage during the summer. Trunks shipped to camp will be placed in the cabin, next to your camper's bunk before arrival. You are more than welcome to bring the trunk with you. Nametags

Camp clothes look the same. All items must be labeled clearly and permanently with names. You would be amazed how many items are left at the end of the summer. We return everything of value that is labeled but there are always a lot of items that we cannot return either because they were never labeled or the labels have come off. Please make sure everything is well labeled. Beware of labels that might fall off in the laundry!

Laundry

The laundry goes out every Monday and is returned the next day. Boys need enough uniforms to get through a week of rugged outdoor use. The boys must have 2 Official Camp Timanous laundry bags with their name clearly written on the front. The camp laundry bag is available from Maine Camp Outfitters.

Towels

Campers should bring several small- or medium-sized, fast-drying towels. We find that the large, thick towels do not dry easily either when hanging on the clothesline or in the dryer at the laundry. Because the laundry does each camper's laundry as one load, the larger, thicker towels either come back damp or the rest of the laundry is slightly cooked. Towels which remain damp are unsanitary, so we are suggesting that campers bring enough towels to use a new one each day and encourage the use of smaller and fast drying towels. Please make sure the towels are well labeled with your camper's name.

Electronics

Please leave phones, iPads, Kindles, Apple Watch, Electronic Games, etc. at home. Acoustic instruments are welcome.

Books

We provide quiet time to read and relax in the cabins so boys have many opportunities to read.

The Camp Store

The "store" is a small closet in the office where boys can obtain small necessities like toothbrushes, toothpaste, batteries, etc. You do not need to send any money.
